Frequency: Weekly on Wednesdays

Preschool - Students will begin with learning letters and sounds. They will move onto sounding out words, reading sight words, and writing basic words and sentences. Children will also do a hands-on STEM lesson every week with older children enrolled in classes.

STEM- This class will offer hands-on activities based on science, technology, engineering, mathematics. Students will work on both individual and group projects.

3rd-12th Grade Art:

Art from Around the World- Students are introduced to art from around the world and will learn about different cultures and their art. Multi-media techniques will be used, and the students will explore different mediums including watercolors,

K-2 Grade Art:

Multi Media Process Art- Students are exploring and creating multi-media art while learning basic art elements of line, shape, balance, and texture. Students will have fun as they create their own collage papers, and use pastels, watercolors and tempura paints to express their art in every class.

Socratic Seminar - Students will learn the method of Socratic seminar and apply it to various texts or media. Students will engage in thoughtful dialogue to gain consensus or conclusions often digging deeper into ethics and/or moral conscience. Student participation is mandatory. A minimum of 6 registered students needed for class to be offered.

Treasured Talks with Father- Kids will enjoy their snack time with Father Yanta. Talks will go wherever the Holy Spirit leads them.

Game Time- Time has been allocated for all ages to play board games with one another. SHH will provide some but encourage students to bring their favorite to play with their peers.

Choir I- We will be focusing on pitch and tone. The songs will be children's hymns, and some simple Latin chants. Reading will not be required as most of it will be memorized.

Choir II- We will be practicing pitch, tone, dynamics and pronunciation. There will be an opportunity for solo parts with the possibility of harmony. We will be singing sacred hymns and Latin hymns in preparation for liturgical feasts.
